Day 1 – Depart USA

Day 2 – Arrive Paris

Day 3 – From our hotel we take a short walk across the Pont Neuf to the Louvre followed by a bateau ride to Eiffel Tower with elevator ride to the top Day 4 – We begin the day with a private walking tour. The first stop includes chocolate. The last stop is an interior visit of Notre Dame.

Day 5 – Afternoon visit to Versailles, the palace of the Sun King.

Day 6 - Today is free to see some museums or shop. Don't miss the d'Orsay for the remarkable Impressionist works.

Day 7 – This morning Montmartre and its artists are calling. The funicular takes us up the steep hill to the Sacre Coeur and Montmartre. Le Petit Train de Montmartre will take us on a short tour of this Bohemian neighborhood. You will have time to commission a sketch of yourself from one of the starving artists if you choose. From there we will treat our noses to the Fragonard Perfume Museum followed by a walk to Angelina's for Le Goûter (after school snack).

Day 8 – Morning departure for home
