3 December - Tuesday

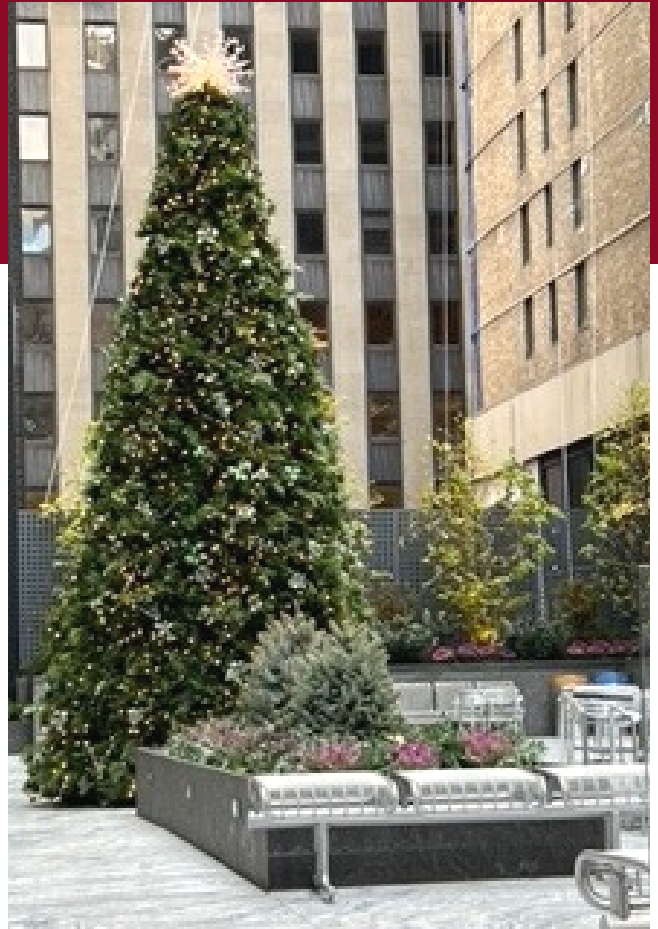
